I was concerned to learn that a presentation to external industry stakeholders last week following STC may have included fire protection material without the necessary approval or departmental awareness. In terms of a joint briefing to the MO perhaps one on the broader fire protection licensing implementation as initially planned pre-caretaker would be a more suitable way forward?
