## Rockhampton and Hervey Bay community consultation Improving sustainable housing in Queensland

#### **Purpose**

To advise that the Department of Infrastructure and Planning will hold a community consultation meeting on 23 July 2008 and host a shopping centre display on 24 July 2008 in Rockhampton and a shopping centre display on 25 July 2008 in Hervey Bay to seek public comment on the *Improving sustainable housing in Queensland* discussion paper.

#### **Background**

<u>Building Newsflash 320</u> advised when the public consultation process for the <u>Improving sustainable housing in Queensland</u> discussion paper commenced. The discussion paper provides Queensland residents with the opportunity to have their say on a range of suggested sustainable housing improvements proposed by the Queensland Government. The proposed improvements will help make Queensland homes more naturally comfortable, use less water and energy, and assist residents in making an informed decision about sustainable housing features when they buy or rent. A range of measures for new and existing homes are included in the discussion paper.

The Honourable Paul Lucas MP, Deputy Premier and Minister for Infrastructure and Planning, will attend the community consultation session on Wednesday 23 July 2008. The Honourable Andrew McNamara, Minister for Sustainability, Climate Change and Innovation, will attend the shopping centre display on Friday 25 July 2008.
