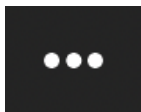

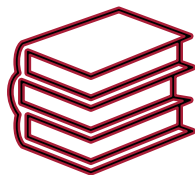
Program overseen at senior levels, with ongoing industry and union consultation.
