Queensland businesses set to save with new energy efficiency rebates

Rebates for energy efficient appliances and equipment are now available to help drive down electricity consumption and costs for small-to-medium scale Queensland businesses.

The rebates are part of the Queensland Business Energy Savings Transformation (QBEST) program, an initiative under the Queensland Energy and Jobs Plan, to assist businesses better manage their electricity consumption and bills.

Businesses that purchase and install eligible energy efficient equipment from 5 October can apply for rebates of up to \$12,500 to cover 50 per cent of energy efficiency upgrade costs.

Eligible energy efficiency upgrades cover a range of equipment including heating and cooling systems, 4-star energy rated appliances and lighting upgrades.

Businesses must spend a minimum of \$8,000 (excluding GST) on the purchase and installation of eligible equipment to apply for the rebate.

Round one of the QBEST Rebates is open until funding is exhausted.
