# Work Health and Safety for QBuild

We are committed to Zero Harm at Work. This means our Work Health and Safety (WHS) objective is to cause no harm to any worker, contractor, customer or member of the public, any time while at work.

All contractors and subcontractors must comply with all current <u>Work Health and Safety (WHS)</u> <u>legislation</u> when providing works and services for <u>QBuild</u>.

## **Online Induction**

To assist in managing WHS obligations while working on QBuild sites and to comply with legal obligations, a WHS online induction has been developed. Contractors, including approved subcontractors and their workers, must complete the QBuild WHS induction before starting work on a QBuild site.

This induction must be successfully completed by all contractors and their workers including approved subcontractors before any work can be performed on QBuild sites throughout Queensland.

You can complete the induction at any time after your successful QBuild registration and/or subcontractor approval. The induction takes about 40 minutes and involves a short assessment. A certificate will be available after successfully completing a short assessment which you will be able to download. Once downloaded ensure you can access it easily via either your mobile device or hard copy when you work on-site.

A QBuild representative may ask to see the induction certificate during on-site inspections and verify against your ID (please ensure to complete in the name as per your ID). Any contractor who doesn't have a current QBuild induction certificate must stop work.

Upon completion of the online induction, you will receive a card similar to the example below.
