

Battery Booster Program

Approved Installer certification and acknowledgement

By applying to become an Approved Installer for the Queensland Government's Battery Booster Program ('the Program'), you ('the Applicant') will need to agree to adhere to the following terms and conditions:

1. All installations of residential solar battery systems under the Program are to be in accordance with all applicable Australian Standards and best practice processes including, but not limited to (*Applicant to confirm which of the below standards will be compliant with*):

2. All installations of residential solar battery systems under the Program may be subject to an inspection by the Department of Energy and Climate ('the Department') appointed Battery Booster compliance and safety inspectorate ('Appointed Inspectorate'). The inspections by the Appointed Inspectorate will be focused on the safety of the residential solar battery system installation and all associated equipment, including the household's solar PV system, and the adherence of the installation to all applicable Australian Standards and best practice processes as described in Item 1 above.

Acknowledgements and certifications

The Applicant, in applying to be registered by the Department as an Approved Installer for the purposes of the Program:

- (a) certifies that the Applicant has read, understands and complies with all the requirements of the registration process, including any changes made and notified by the Department;
- (b) represents that all the information provided by the Applicant in connection with the registration process is complete, accurate, up to date and not misleading in any way;
- (c) acknowledges that the Department will rely on the information provided by the Applicant when deciding whether or not to register the Applicant as an Approved Installer for the purposes of the Program;
- (d) acknowledges that the Department has the right to refuse or revoke the registration of the Applicant from the Program if the Applicant is found to have breached any of the requirements within the application or this certification and acknowledgement form. This includes if the breach is identified by the Appointed Inspectorate;
- (e) acknowledge that the Department maintains the right to publish on its website the business information including name of business, ABN and contractor's licence number if they are found to have breached any requirements as found by the Department or Appointed Inspectorate.
- (f) acknowledges that the Department may suffer damage if any of the information submitted by the Applicant is incomplete, inaccurate, out of date or misleading in any way; and
- (g) acknowledges that if any information submitted by the Applicant is found to be incomplete, inaccurate, out of date or misleading, or if the Department is made aware of changes to the Applicant's information after registration, this may result in revocation of the Applicant's registration as an Approved Installer for the purposes of the Program (such revocation being without prejudice to any other rights of the Department).

published on the Department's website and will include some of your personal information. Your personal information may be disclosed to

- the Queensland Rural and Industry Development Authority (QRIDA), the Electrical Safety Office, Energy Queensland Limited, and other government agencies for the purpose of administering the Program, including the investigation, management and resolution of any complaints; and
- to the Appointed Inspectorate for the purpose of confirming your eligibility to be an Approved Installer.

Limited personal information may be used for related research, policy or planning functions. Unless authorised or required by law, your personal information will not otherwise be disclosed to any other third party without your consent.
