Maintenance costs include scheduled and unscheduled maintenance, repairs, end of life repairs and tyres.

3. The cost to upgrade vehicles for 2020 and 2021 respectively.

QFleet procures vehicles to meet each agencies specifications and service delivery requirements, this includes additional accessory or option fitments or fit-outs which are ordered through the manufacture at the time of procurement to ensure the vehicle is fit-for-purpose. Lease terms average 3 to 4 years, at which time agencies determine if a vehicle is going to be returned and replaced with a new vehicle lease or returned with no replacement.

QFleet has extracted the cost of Replacement Vehicles (of existing leases) for 2020 & 21 from its database.

Reasoning for nil response:

- QFleet does not lease any vehicles to agencies that fit the category or criteria of being for a special reason, or an upgrade or a non-standard replacement.
- QFleet makes motor vehicles available to government agencies and other eligible customers using the following main criteria:
 - Fit for purpose
 - Value for Money
 - Safe as possible with a 5-star ANCAP rating where it is exists
 - Within pre-determined CO₂ limits
- QFleet maintains two list of vehicles to assist agencies with their vehicle selection process
 - Standard list
 - Agencies use this list for their fleet needs
 - This is regularly updated for suitable new vehicles released by manufacturers and where certain vehicles are not available due to production or supply issues
 - Executive list
 - This list is only applicable to a very small portion of agencies and is only for employees who
 have entitlements associated with their employment conditions
- Agencies use these vehicle lists to help guide their decision-making processes to select a vehicle.
- Agencies have their own fleet policies which determine which vehicle they choose. These policies also determine what internal approval processes exist to execute the lease agreement.
