



Program for making emissions reduction plans

The *Clean Economy Jobs Act 2024* (the Act) provides for the making of emissions reduction plans. Section 11 of the Act states that the Minister responsible for the Act must prepare a program stating the following matters:

- (a) the sectors for which emissions reduction plans must be made;
- (b) the Ministers responsible for making the plans;
- (c) the periods for which the plans are to have effect;
- (d) the days by which the plans must be published on the Queensland government website.

This program is published in accordance with the requirements of the Act.
